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- 5.4 Safety Considerations:
 - 5.4.1 placementocation that is conducive to supervisiong., site lines are maintained.
 - 5.4.2 ramps or stairlifts wilhot be provided to access a portable because of concerns egarding the amount of space required for an exterior ramp as defined by the OntariBuilding Code (slope of 1:20) and winter maintenance safety concerns.
- 5.5 Rationale for Location Selection
 - 5.5.1 Generally, portables will be placed where portables have previously been positioned.
 - 5.5.2 Historical and site conditions will influence the preferred location and therefore a comparable location will be agreed upon.
 - 5.5.3 Manager Engineering and Construction Services, or designate will meet with the school principal to review the preferred location. In the case where an agreement cannot be reacthed family of schools superintendent and Executive Officer, FairlitServices will make the final determination
 - 5.5.4 These criteria will guide the decisiosite specific limitations will drive the final decision.
 - The portable classroom should be located a minimum of 12.2 metres (40 fee) from themain building (Ontario Building Codequiremen)t,
 - avoid routes in or near parking areas and access, roads
 - direct path of travel to an exterior door of the school.
 - hard surface (i.easphalt, walkways only to portables) preventing mud, snow, and waterom being tracked into the portable or school
 - access for emergency vehicles
 - budgeted costs for installation of portable classroomesuding the costs for hydro, fire alarm and data networking etc. connections, as well as site preparation
