Introduction

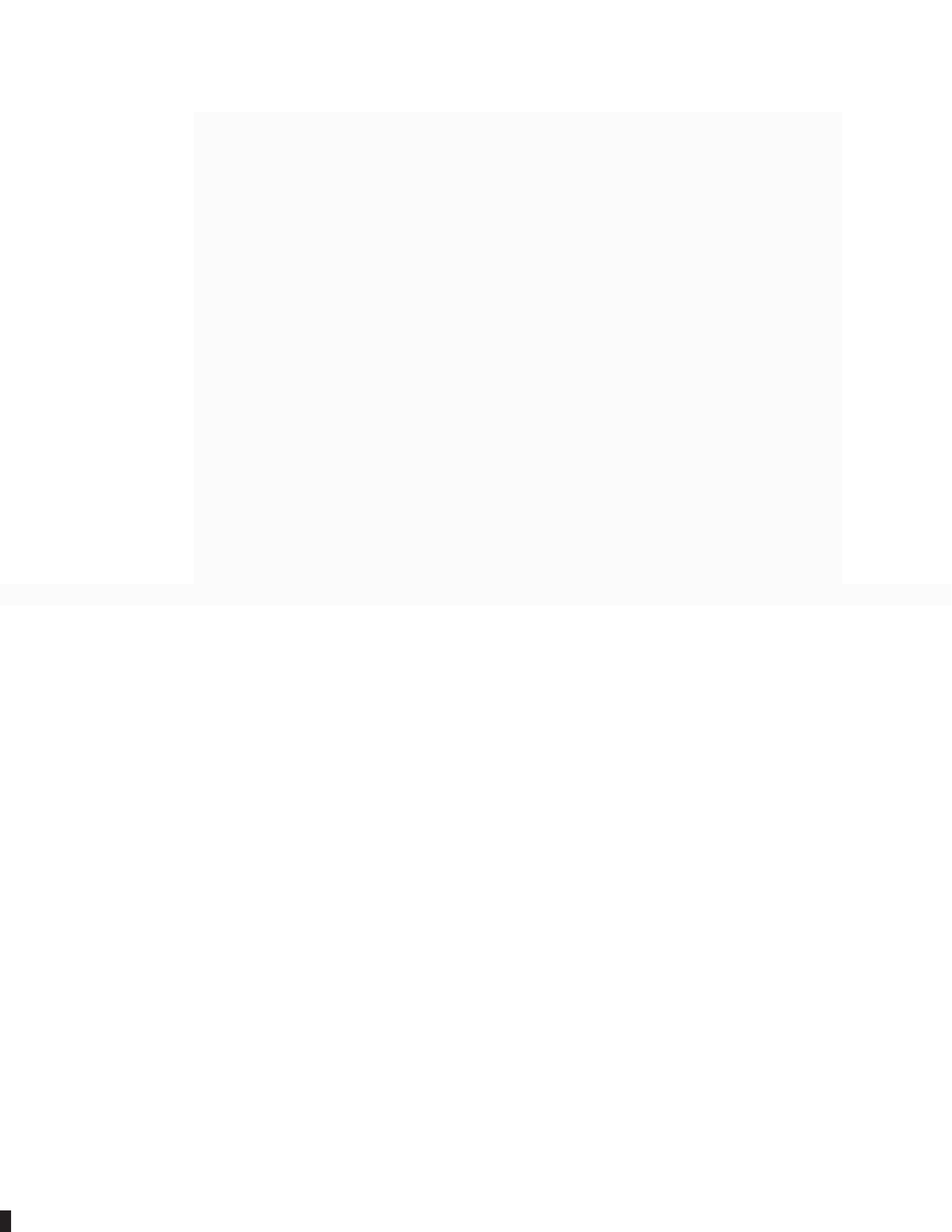
Welcome to the 2024-2025 Climate Survey for KPRDSB students in Grades 4, 5 and 6.
